How to Apply

This funding has a two-stage application process with the following deadlines:

Stage 1: Complete the readiness survey as soon as possible to determine whether you are eligible to apply.

Stage 2: Eligible projects will be invited to submit an application by June 30, 2020, 11:59 p.m. Pacific Time.

If you are **not** eligible to apply, sign up for our e-newsletter to stay informed about other funding opportunities.

Pre-requisites for Call for Applications #1:

1. Approved energy/climate action plan
2. Market study, business case or feasibility study
3. Council-approved program design bylaw or similar resolution
4. Attestation from City Manager to capitalize a program
5. Proof of legal authority
